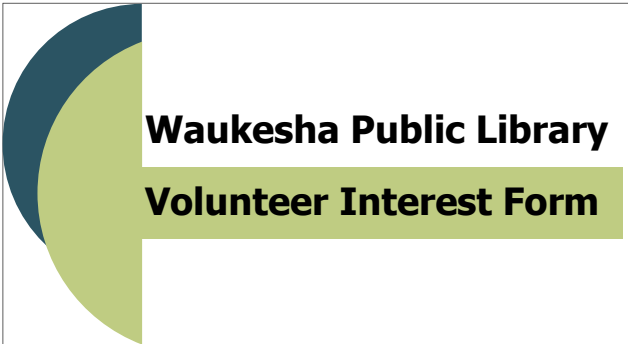

Please check primary areas of interest

- Lobby Ambassador***
Greet customers as they enter the library and offer general directions; assist with SelfCheck and copy machines.
- Shelve AV***
Put audiobooks, and music CDs on the shelf for customers to browse and check out.
- Shelf Maintenance ***
Pick a favorite fiction or non-fiction subject area; keep in order.
- Put book carts in order***
Alphabetize and organize carts in Dewey Decimal order.
- Check AV contents***
Match DVD and CD cases with the contents.
- Mend damaged library books***
Repair books so that they can continue to be read and enjoyed by others.
- On Call Special Projects/Events***
Assist with special projects and events on an as needed basis.
- Teen Event Aide***
Help out with teen programs
- Bookleggers***
Promote children's books and reading at classroom visits.
- Community Outreach***
Assist in the delivery of library materials to the homebound.
